The attached form describes sponsorship and all other levels of support for the Historic Moffat Library Grand Re-Opening Ceremony.

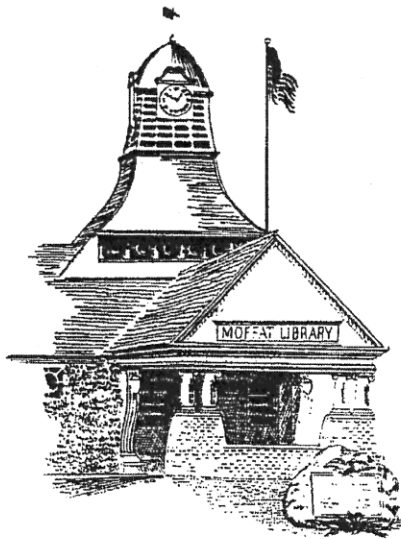
