Summer Reading Program for Parents & Their Children

Ages 6 Months-5 Years

(Excluding Kindergarteners)

...because you're never too young to love books (even if you're trying to eat them!)

HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS:

1. Parents with children ages 6 months - 5 years are encouraged to read at least 25 picture or board books to their child between June 26th and July 24th.
2. Participants can log their reading using our online Summer Reading website (accessible from www.moffatlibrary.org).
3. Children are allowed to choose a prize from our treasure chest every time they log books with out volunteers.
4. Stop by the library **Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, or Saturday** during the reading program to report on your reading progress
5. On June 26th, Summer Reading, Participants will receive a free book!

Summer Reading Program for Grades K-6



HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS:

1. Children who are entering kindergarten through 6th grade are asked to read for **at least** 600 minutes between June 26th and July 24th (that's only 20 minutes a day!)
2. Participants can log their reading using our online Summer Reading website (accessible from www.moffatlibrary.org).
3. Stop by the library **Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, or Saturday** during the program to report on your reading progress and earn raffle tickets (1 raffle ticket for every 60 minutes of reading).
4. Children are allowed to choose a prize from our treasure chest every time they log books with our volunteers.
5. To start off your reading, pick up a free book on June 26th!

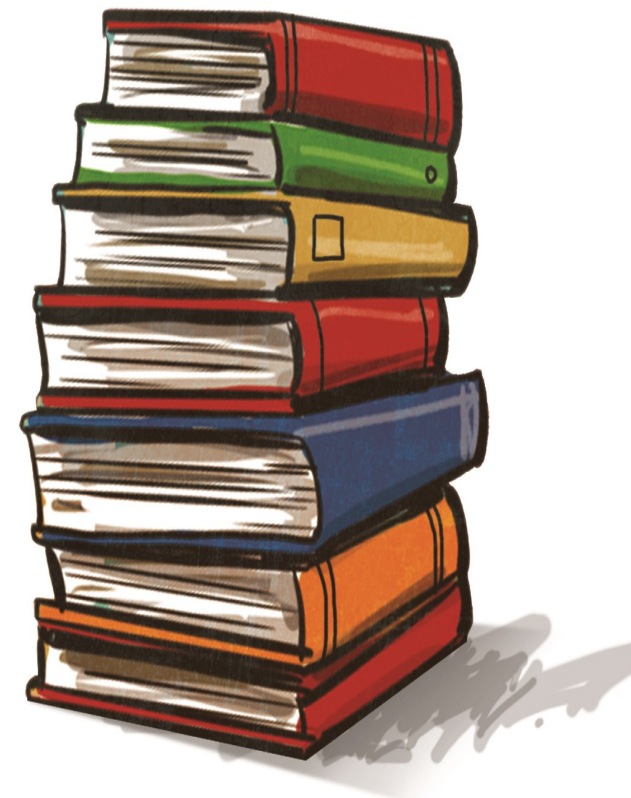
MAKE READING A FAMILY AFFAIR

Teen Summer Reading Program for Grades 7-12

HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS:

1. Teens are encouraged to read for **at least** 600 minutes during Summer Reading (that's only 20 minutes a day!)
2. When you finish a book, go online and log your reading @ www.moffatlibrary.org.
3. Teens earn a raffle ticket for every 60 minutes they read and each program they attend during Summer Reading.
4. Please see Emily, Elly, or Nik to receive raffle tickets for your reading. We will have weekly drawings so don't wait till the end of summer to check in!
5. All reading must be reported by July 24th!



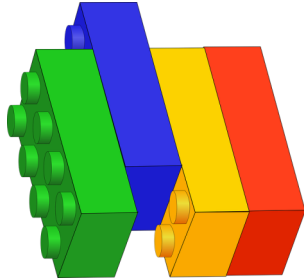
ADULT SUMMER READING PROGRAM FOR "KIDS" AGES 18 AND UP!

How the Program Works:

1. Raffle tickets will be awarded for every book read between June 26th and July 24th and logged online. Go to our website www.moffatlibrary.org to register.
2. Adults are also encouraged to sign up and attend any adult, or family programs during the Summer Reading Program (June 26th - July 24th). Use our online calendar at www.moffatlibrary.org to register. After attending the program and completing a "Build a Better World" raffle ticket, the adult is automatically entered in a raffle for a prize or gift bag.
3. Adults and families who show they volunteered or participated in a community-based club or project by completing a Citizens Activity Sheet receive a chance to win a special prize, and the prestige of being "Master Builder!"

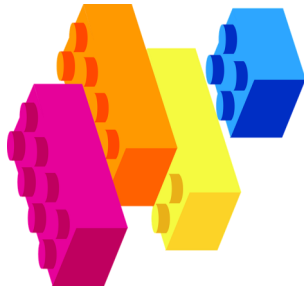
