## **TUTORING POLICY**

Tutoring is an activity which relates to the library's role as an educational support center. Use of the library's meeting room space is permitted for non-profit (e.g. Literacy Volunteers) or Washingtonville Central School District sanctioned tutoring activities, subject to availability.

The following guidelines are to be observed:

- 1. Tutors will contact the library to reserve use of the meeting room space. A Meeting Room request form will be kept on file for each tutor.
- 2. The library reading room is not available for tutoring as this space is reserved for research, reading and study.
- 3. School aged students being tutored in the library are the responsibility of the tutor while on library property until released to a parent/guardian or authorized transportation.
- 4. Students of the Washingtonville Central School District who are being tutored at the Moffat Library must have a valid Moffat Library card.
