MOFFAT LIBRARY

TUTORING POLICY

Tutoring is an activity which relates to the library's role as an educational support center. Use of library space is permitted for non-profit (e.g. Literacy Volunteers) or Washingtonville Central School District sanctioned tutoring activities for students residing in the School District, subject to availability.

The following guidelines are to be observed:

- 1. Tutors are permitted to use the main areas of the Library for tutoring purposes provided they are not disruptive and provided they are in compliance with the *Rules of Behavior For Use Of Library Facilities Policy* and all other policies of the Library.
- 2. School aged students being tutored in the library are the responsibility of the tutor while on library property until released to a parent/guardian or authorized transportation.
- 3. Students of the Washingtonville Central School District who are being tutored at the Moffat Library must have a valid Moffat Library card.
