MOFFAT LIBRARY'S BUDGET FOR FY 2021-22 REMAINS FLAT FOR THE 2nd YEAR IN A ROW

As we look back over the past year, we are still faced with a great deal of uncertainty even now about the future. We know that many people have struggled and continue to struggle in our community. We have seen very clearly that our citizens have already been burdened with so much.

As a public library, our role is to help our community members in any way that we can because we are community members too. To that end, The Trustees of the Moffat Library of Washingtonville unanimously agreed to keep their funding levels the same as FY2019-20. What that means to you is that **your library taxes will remain unchanged** (from 2019-20 levels) for both the current year (FY2020-21) and for the upcoming year (FY2021-22).
