WIRELESS USE POLICY

Moffat Library of Washingtonville is pleased to provide free wireless Internet access for the use of our patrons. As a precondition for having access to the wireless network, patrons agree to abide by the following rules:

Patrons must accept the library's Internet Policy & User Agreement and rules for access to the Internet. Paper copies of this policy are also available upon request at the circulation desk.

The Moffat Library of Washingtonville's Internet Portal provides unrestricted, unfiltered and unsupervised access to the internet. It is the User's or, in the case of a minor, the User's parent or legal guardian's responsibility to evaluate for themselves the validity and appropriateness of any materials accessed. Patrons must comply with all state and federal laws including those related to obscenity, pornography and delivery to minors of materials deemed harmful to them.

The patron is entirely responsible for setting up his or her laptop or other electronic communication device to permit wireless access through the library's network. (See Electronic Communications Devices Policy).

Moffat Library of Washingtonville does not assume any responsibility for the safety and integrity of personal equipment, laptop or other electronic communication device configurations or data files.

Moffat Library of Washingtonville cannot vouch for the security of wireless communications. It is strongly advised that wireless communication not be used for the transmission of sensitive or personal information.

Patrons are responsible for providing virus protection for their personal equipment.

Moffat Library of Washingtonville staff members cannot configure a person's personal laptop or other electronic communication device or provide assistance with the installation of hardware or software.

Moffat Library of Washingtonville cannot vouch for the reliability of any website nor the success of any online transaction.

Moffat Library of Washingtonville wireless network may require periodic maintenance, and the library cannot be held responsible for unforeseen down time.

Patrons using personal laptops or other electronic communication devices in a manner disturbing to others in the library will be asked to turn off the equipment. Repeated violation of this rule will result in suspension of user privileges.
