



MEMBERSHIP POLICY

Moffat Library of Washingtonville

For Adults ages 18 and up:

To obtain a Moffat Library card you must be a resident of the Washingtonville Central School District. A photo ID and proof of current address must be presented.

For Children ages 0 - 17 years:

Children ages 0 to 17 years old are eligible for a library card. In order to register children ages 17 and under for a Moffat Library card, a parent/guardian must show proof of identification or their Moffat Library card and sign their child's library card application.

Parents/guardians are responsible for: all items borrowed on their child's card; any damage to library materials, buildings or contents; and ensuring that their child adheres to all library policies.

Parents/guardians should be aware that there are no restrictions on the type of materials a child can borrow with a Moffat Library card. If you feel some material may be inappropriate for your child, it is your responsibility to convey that to your child. To assist you with this, the library catalog gives you the option of saving your child's borrowing history, so that you can review it periodically online. A staff member can show you how to set this up.
